2021-2022 THHS PTSA Mini-Grants

THHS PTSA provides Mini-Grants to teachers and/or staff to supplement or expand existing instruction on campus for the 2021-2022 school year. The grants are intended for educational items or supplies to promote student learning that are not funded by the school or district. Priority will be given to those programs that reach and have an impact on the largest number of students on a school level, followed by departmental requests.

Criteria: The applications will be prioritized according to the following criteria:

1. 2021-2022 THHS PTSA members (applicants are not required to be members, but priority is given to members).
2. Number of students the proposal will directly affect.
3. Long-term effect of the proposal (one-time or annual expenditure vs. continued usability).
4. Limits/options for alternative funding.
5. Applicants who did not receive a THHS PTSA Mini-Grant during the 2020-2021 school year.

Process:

- A. Applicants shall prepare a PTSA Mini Grant application and submit it to the PTSA by the submittal deadline. Completed applications should be emailed to deniselko@gmail.com. The PTSA Mini-Grant Committee will review all proposals and evaluate them according to the above criteria and make their recommendations for approval to the PTSA Executive Board. The Executive Board's recommendations will then be presented to the Association for approval.
- B. Each applicant will be notified via e-mail of their application status.
- C. Purchases for approved grants will be worked out individually with each recipient. If the applicant makes any purchases, he/she will need to turn in the original receipt(s) to the PTSA Mini-Grant Chair (Denise Ko). In the event the receipt amount exceeds the grant award, only the amount of the grant award will be reimbursed unless previously approved by the PTSA. Any equipment, software, or supplies purchased with PTSA monies become the property of THHS. Should the grant recipient discontinue working at THHS, anything purchased with the Mini-Grant remains the property of Trabuco Hills High School.
