



## 2023 Graduating High School Senior Scholarship

**Purpose:** The Trabuco Hills High PTSA offers graduating Senior scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors in their school, on the THHS PTSA, and in the community.

**Availability:** Scholarship funds are available to high school seniors who are currently PTSA members or Friends of PTSA at Trabuco Hills High School and graduating between January and June of the current academic year. This scholarship needs to be used during the fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited college or university, community college or trade/technical school.

**Application and due date:** An application may be obtained at [www.thhsptsa.org/scholarships](http://www.thhsptsa.org/scholarships) or from the Guidance office. References are to be completed by an adult who can speak on behalf of your qualifications. The completed reference form and letter should be directly emailed to [TrabucoHillsPTSA@gmail.com](mailto:TrabucoHillsPTSA@gmail.com) or given to the applicant in a sealed envelope to be included with the application packet. Do not submit more than one reference form or letter.

Original application, essay responses, and reference letter are to be submitted to either [TrabucoHillsPTSA@gmail.com](mailto:TrabucoHillsPTSA@gmail.com) or Shanti Lunsford in the THHS Guidance office by **April 21st by 1pm**. Applications will not be considered if received after the due date or if any of the required materials are missing.

**Qualifications:** This scholarship recognizes an outstanding student in the school, PTSA and community who has a minimum grade point average of 2.0 or higher. Consideration will be given to students for the following: Academic Achievement, Community Service, Leadership, PTSA Involvement, School Participation, Financial Need. **Selection:** Recipients are selected by representatives of the Trabuco Hills High Senior Scholarship Committee and approved at a PTSA association meeting. A check for the scholarship will be given directly to the recipient at the Senior Award Night ceremony.
